What Is CNA and What Does It Do for the Whole Neighborhood?

- CNA is the "Face of the Neighborhood" to the City of Garland since its formation in 1980.
- Beautifies the entrances to the neighborhood on King Arthur (at Jupiter) and Collins Boulevard (at Shiloh).
- Hosts a website CamelotNA.com. Lots of neighborhood history and info can be found there.
- Holds monthly meetings via Zoom open to all residents and city officials. (See the website calendar.)
- Works closely with Garland Code Compliance to make sure that the appearance of the neighborhood is attractive and does not decline.
- Sponsors Annual Picnic and Chili Cook Off in early October.
- Sponsors Yard of the Month award May to October and Yard of the Year in October; Christmas Lights contest in December.

The Camelot Neighborhood Association strives to keep Camelot residents informed, using several different media to contact as many neighbors as possible.

Newsletter: Our award-winning newsletter, *The Knightly News*, is emailed to CNA members every month. (Paper copies available upon request.) It typically has six to eight pages, and includes news and photos about the neighborhood and columns written by the CNA President, the District 7 Council Member, CNA meeting minutes, crime prevention and safety info and monthly crime stats, gardening tips, Yard of the Month photos, annual picnic coverage, etc. And page 2 of each newsletter has handy lists of CNA and various city contact information.

Website: The CNA website is <u>www.camelotna.com</u>. The home page describes the neighborhood and is a map to the entire website. The Our Info section includes a list of CNA officers and committee chairs with their contact information, an interactive map of the neighborhood, and a history of CNA. Pages & Links opens to Association Information, Neighborhood Information, Crime & Safety, and external links to many Internet sites that are of interest to neighbors. A calendar lists upcoming events in the neighborhood. Information on the website is available to the public.
